WOODFORDS CLUB GOLF LEAGUE

2010 Season

-Rules-

1. Each player must be a member in good standing of the Woodfords Club. Each player will donate \$10.00 to be used for the season's golf prize awards. Payment required before 1st day of play. Captains responsible for collection.
2. All matches must be played at Twin Falls Golf Course, Westbrook, ME (854-5397); the greens fee for each League 9 hole play is \$10.00 and is payable at the golf shop. Anyone wanting to play more than 9 holes must first obtain approval from the shop.
3. Tee-off time: MONDAYS, from 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m.
4. All matches must be played Monday of scheduled week or played prior to the week scheduled.
5. All matches will be one-on-one competition. There will be no matching of golf scores. The difference in handicap determines the number of holes given.
6. No make up and no forfeit.
7. No Playoff – one continuous season based on teams and weeks played. Best team with most points will be league champs. In case of ties, exception will be initiated and a match play (9 holes) will be played on a designated day of the last week of regular league play.

8. Point & System: System Match Play Format
Points Hole won = 1 point
Hole halved = ½ point

9. Missing Opponent: Did not contact 5 points
Did contact (i.e. legitimate excuse, work, sick, family problem,, leave town, etc.) 6 points
Missing golfer 3 points
Both golfers missing 0 points

10. Start season with 2009 handicap, thereafter will be adjusted each week. If no handicap, one will be assigned based on the golfer's info or committee's knowledge.

11. Play will be from the white markers.

12. Score Cards: Be sure both last names are on the card and that they are legible. Deposit score cards in the blue & white Woodfords Club box in the Golf Shop. Teams and individual standings and handicaps will be posted in the shop before each week's play.

**USGA RULES OF GOLF SHALL
GOVERN ALL PLAY**

(Except as modified below and by the local rules of Twin Falls Golf Course)

1. PREFERRED LIES: a ball lying on a fairway may be lifted, cleaned and placed within one foot (scorecard) of its original position, not nearer to the hole, as near as possible, preserving the stance required to play from the original lie.
2. IMBEDDED BALL: or a ball in casual water may be lifted without penalty, wiped and placed within a reasonable distance NOT nearer the hole.
3. LOST OR OUT-OF-BOUNDS: two club length placement on fairway at point of entry of previously played stroke - likewise for UNPLAYABLE LIE, except in hazard. A drop is also allowable. Either of these situations require a one stroke penalty added to the total strokes for the hole.
4. WATER HAZARD: Ball in pond, brook, any water course or ditch may be lifted and placed within two club lengths of the point of entry, no nearer the hole. Add one stroke penalty.
5. FREE LIFTS: One club length from all paths, roadway, crushed rock drains, animal holes, area under repair, immovable water hoses, sprinklers, artificial structures, benches, a wrong green and tree stake markers.
6. WRONG BALL PLAYED: More than one stroke is a one stroke penalty.
7. PROVISIONAL BALL: Not to be played in ANY circumstances. See #3 above. Any ball watered, add one stroke penalty and play from drop area facing the front of the green. This local is written to speed up play.

8. YOU MAY NOT improve your lie or build a stance by moving, pulling, breaking or bending growing vegetation. YOU MAY, however (except in a water hazard, ditch or sandtrap), move loose impediments such as branches, twigs, leaves, loose stones or windblown trash items.

9. DO replace all turf-level footprints in bunkers, repair ball marks on greens, keep bags and carts off tees and greens, use trash containers, invite faster players through promptly on par 3 hole before putting out, invite the group behind to tee off and note their ball position for courtesy and speeding up play.

GOLF ETIQUETTE REMINDER

1. Go to your ball in fairway or rough and be ready to hit when it is your turn.
2. When your ball reaches the green, observe your distance to the hole compared to other players and be prepared to putt when your turn arises.
3. After you putt, if you are not in any other putter's line, PUTT OUT, otherwise, mark your ball again.
